

2018 CSFP INCOME CRITERIA

Prior to receiving USDA food each household must certify that their household's current income does not exceed the listed below amounts on all required State forms:

For each additional household member add \$468 per month.

Misrepresentation of need, sale or exchange, receiving from more than one agency during a CSFP distribution month or misuse of USDA commodities is prohibited and could result in a fine, imprisonment, or both. In accordance with Federal civil rights law and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) civil rights regulations and policies, the USDA, its Agencies, offices, and employees, and institutions participating in or administering USDA programs are prohibited from discriminating based on race, color, national origin, sex, disability, age, or reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity in any program or activity conducted or funded by USDA.
