



2016-17 INCOME CRITERIA

Prior to receiving USDA food each household must certify that their household's current income does not exceed the listed below amounts on all required State forms:

Misrepresentation of need, sale or exchange, receiving from more than one agency during a TEFAP distribution month or misuse of USDA commodities is prohibited and could result in a fine, imprisonment, or both.
